Water droplet becomes lodged in the ear canal. (Get numb head feeling or aching ears in the evening)



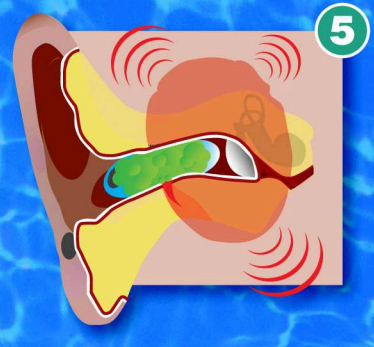

Bacteria have direct access through the skin dermis due to a cut/abrasion/eczema in the ear canal

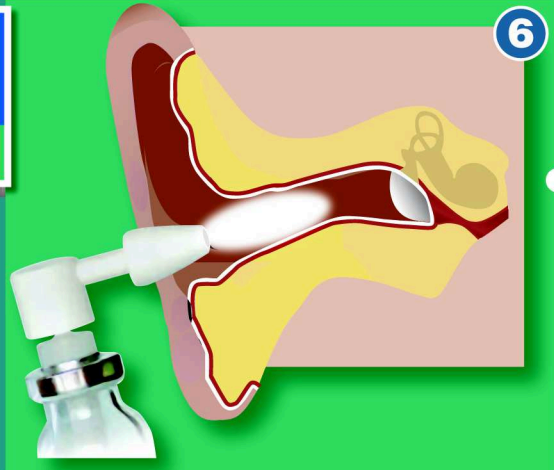
